Biotech Firm Puts R2D2 to Work In Lab

Drug development is a time-consuming and expensive business. Notoriously, it takes over 10 years and costs around \$2 billion to bring one drug to market — and around 90% of candidate drugs fail during human trials. And the situation is getting worse. 
